## Co-development Partner

## Protecting Biodiversity

Wind Prospect and Novera Energy are currently working closely with Environment Australia, the Federal Environment Department, and local experts to ensure the Green Point wind farm will avoid any negative impacts on the endangered Orange-bellied Parrot. To protect the Parrot, the Green Point team is developing a number of environmental strategies for both on and off the wind farm site.

The strategies are part of a wider Environmental Management Program, developed to ensure that the ecology of the site is managed appropriately. Implementation of these environmental management activities will see further investment in the local community by the development partners.

## Wind Monitoring Continues

Wind monitoring on the Green Point site is continuing with both the 50-metre and 10-metre masts continuously recording and collecting wind data. To streamline the data collection process, a new communications system has been installed on the 50-metre mast, permitting remote download of the Green Point wind data on a regular basis.

## Site Visit From Turbine Manufacturer

During the last month a turbine manufacturer visited the Green Point site to investigate construction issues. Importantly, the turbine manufacturer identified no access problems at the site, a common hurdle for wind farm developments, further supporting Wind Prospect's choice of the Green Point area for a wind farm.
